## Save Myles

The Harmony Foundation for Children is proud to support the **Save Myles Organization** (www.savemyles.org), a group created to provide assistance to a very special young boy named Myles Farnsworth. His emotional and moving story will truly touch your heart. In October of 2002 at just 3 years old, Myles was diagnosed with Neuroblastoma. This type of cancer is the most common type among children, with 650 new cases being diagnosed each year. It can be found in the nerve tissue of the adrenal gland, neck, chest or spinal cord or as in Myles' case, it affects the bone marrow. Doctors gave him only a 40% survival rate. Myles and his family immediately headed to St. Louis Children's Hospital to begin treatments and they soon learned that their lives would never be the same again.



Myles' cancer was extremely aggressive from the very start. In turn, he underwent equally aggressive treatments consisting of chemotherapy, stem cell transplant, surgery and radiation. Myles' family, friends and community rallied behind him with support, holding fundraisers to help contribute to his medical bills. Myles also received hundreds of toys

from local charities and organizations. In a truly heart-warming gesture, Myles decided to donate his toys to underprivileged children for Christmas, saying, "I wanted to help other kids to have a good Christmas." Myles was even awarded the *Carpe Diem Award* from the Lance Armstrong Foundation in 2004 for his bravery and good spirits in fighting his disease. Since the diagnosis in 2002, the road has been a rough one for Myles. His cancer went into remission but has since come back even worse. Now at age 6, Myles continues to undergo chemo treatments every 4 weeks, while struggling to enjoy the everyday pleasures and experiences of childhood.

Myles' one wish right now is to go to Hawaii to swim with the dolphins. The Ledson Harmony Foundation wants to help Myles get there by donating half of all the proceeds from the sales of our *Harmony Collection Jeff Bridges* wine.
